

- None of is used for electricity generation







GATWICK GUSHER FLOW TEST From Science Project to Commercial Reality





~1360 bopd aggregate dry stable from Kimmeridge
Natural flow- natural fracturesdual porosity- no depletion seen

- 1,688 BOPD aggregate Kimmeridge
 + Portland stable, dry oil of rate
- Highest stable dry oil rate of any UK onshore discovery Well
- ~ 8.5% of total UK onshore daily oil production

KIMMERIDGE LIMESTONE OIL PRODUCTION




Can be produced with low visual impact

- 12-24 wells in 4-6 acre site
- Wells and pumps below ground level
- Control production to reduce initial road tanker impact
- Can be located in brown field sites and away from villages, houses, small roads

IMPACT ON UK ECONOMY: EY REPORT







Future peak oil production could provide approximately 4% - 27% of UK daily oil demand over the life of the project

Gross Value Added to the UK economy could range from **£7.1 billion to £52.6 billion**

Generates a peak of 8000 to 49000 jobs in the UK

Lifetime tax revenues of between £2.1 billion to £18.1 billion


The journey has just begun

- Consolidate and increase licence holding
 - Control the Kimmeridge Oil play
- Bring Horse Hill/Gatwick Gusher to production
 - 3x 90 day production tests (2016/17)
 - 3D seismic (2017)
 - Horizontal production well (2017/18)

Show HH-1 results can be repeated to south and west in basin sweet-spot

- Holmwood -1 well (2016/17)
- 3 other identified wells (2017/18)
